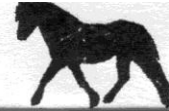

IT IS AN NPS RULE THAT ALL STALLIONS WEAR A BRIDLE BADGE

ALL AFFILIATED IN HAND CLASSES (WITH THE EXCEPTION OF CLASSES 8-13 & 18 WILL BE QUALIFIERS FOR THE "SPILLERS"/EQUIFEST M&M CHAMPIONSHIP. Also Ridden classes 21,22,24 & 26 are Equifest qualifiers - to be held at the EAST OF ENGLAND showground on the 9th-13th August 2017. The two highest placed exhibits not already qualified are eligible. Qualification cards are available from the Equifest office and must be signed ON THE DAY.

CLASSES 1-7 AND 14-17 ARE QUALIFIERS FOR THE NPS Highbrook Stud M&M FINAL.

THE WILBY NEW BREEDERS CHAMPIONSHIP. This is for ponies bred by exhibitors who have registered their FIRST PUREBRED DARTMOOR FOAL WITHIN THE LAST TEN YEARS. Ponies eligible must be produced and led by the owner/spouse or his/her children or grandchildren. Ponies must not have been produced professionally, nor should the owners have produced ponies for other people professionally. Qualifying rosettes will be awarded in the in hand classes to all eligible exhibits, providing the handler is wearing a **WHITE ARMBAND**. All rosette winners will go forward to the championship.

A prize of £10 will be awarded to the champion, reserve and first reserve.

Class 11 Restricted Adults, not to have won at a DPS Star Show before the current year

Class 12 Novice, adults not to have won 2 x 1st before January 2017

Class 13 NPS/SARACEN HORSE FEEDS M&M Home Produced In Hand National Championship (MM-HPIH)

The above class is open to pure bred registered M&M ponies which are either stabled at home or in a DIY yard since the 1st of January in the current year and have not been shown by a producer or stabled in a producers yard other than on a DIY basis or at stud. Ponies shown in these classes must be produced and shown by the owner/spouse, or his her immediate family, who does not receive remuneration (cash or kind) from working with ponies or horses. PLEASE ENTER THIS CLASS IN THE SPIRIT IT IS INTENDED. COMPETITORS WHO CONTRAVENE THE ABOVE WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.

RIDDEN CLASSES RING TWO

JUDGE Miss J Paterson

Class 19 The NPS/The King's Head M&M Novice Leading rein National Championship (MM-NLR).

Open to registered Dartmoor mares and geldings 4 years old and over not exceeding 122cms. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but must not have attained their 9th birthday before the 1st of January in the current year. Ponies never to have won a first prize of £5 or more in Leading Rein classes or qualified for the NPS/Showing classic M&M Leading Rein final before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in a snaffle bit with lead rein attached to nose band only.

Class 20 The NPS M&M Novice First Ridden National Championship (MM-NFR)

Open to registered Dartmoor mares and geldings 4 years old and over not exceeding 128cms. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but must not have reached their 12th birthday before the 1st of January in the current year. Ponies never to have won a first prize of £5 or more in First Ridden classes or qualified for the NPS/Showing Classic M&M First Ridden final before the 1st of January in the current year.

Class 21 The NPS/Showing Classics M&M Open Leading Rein National Championship and Cavernoma Alliance UK/Equifest M&M Lead Rein. (MM-LR)

Open to registered Dartmoor mares and geldings 4 years and over not exceeding 122cms, Riders to have attained their 3rd birthday but must not have attained their 9th birthday in the current year. To be shown in a snaffle bit with lead reins attached to the noseband only.
Home Produced to wear white armbands.

Class 22 The NPS/Showing Classics M&M Open First Ridden National Championship and Nathan Arnold Show Team/Equifest M&M First Ridden (MM-FR)

Open to registered Dartmoor mares and geldings 4 years and over not exceeding 128cms. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but must not have attained their 12^h birthday before the 1st of January in the current year.
Home Produced to wear white armbands.

MINI CHAMPIONSHIP. 1st and 2nd prize winners for classes 19 to 22

Class 23 The NPS/Picton M&M Novice Ridden Championship (MM-NR)
Open to pure bred registered Dartmoor stallions, mares and geldings 4 years and over.

A pony is not eligible to compete if, before the 1st of January in the current year it has done any of the following:

- i) won an open NPS affiliated mixed M&M ridden class
- ii) won a Ridden class in an Olympia, HOYS or RIHS qualifying round
- iii) qualified for HOYS or RIHS ridden class
- iv) qualified for the M&M Novice or Intermediate ridden final at the NPS Summer Show (NB Ponies can compete as novices in this competition for two consecutive years provided they do not submit an entry to the final in the first year)
- v) qualified for the M&M Ridden Championship Olympia final in previous years
- vi) if a pony qualifies for HOYS or RIHS in its second year it is immediately de-noviced and cannot compete in Picton final.

Ponies must be shown in a snaffle bit

Class 24 The NPS/Ryehouse Native Show Team M&M Junior Ridden National Championship (MM-JR) and The John Paton/Equifest Junior Ridden M&M
Open to registered Dartmoor mare and geldings 4 years old and over. Riders must not have attained their 14th birthday before the 1st of January in the current year.

Home Produced to wear white armbands

Class 25 The NPS/Dargavel M&M Young Open Pony National Championships (MM-4/5/6R)

Open to pure bred registered Dartmoor stallions, mares and geldings 4, 5 and 6 years old .A 4 year old that qualifies for the final but does not submit an entry for the final will retain its novice status as a 5 year old. Rider any age, except stallions where the rider must be 12 years and over in the current year. Ages will be split at NPS Final.

Home Produced to wear white armbands

Class 26 The NPS/Ringside Stud M&M Open Ridden National Championship and The Hewitt Family/Equifest Open Ridden M&M (MM-OR)

Open to pure bred registered Dartmoors stallions, mares and geldings 4 years and over. Riders any age except stallions where riders must be 12 years and over in the current year.

Home Produced to wear white armbands

Class 27 The BLUE CHIP NATIVE B.S.P.S. SUPREME CHAMPIONSHIP RIDDEN CLASS. 1st and 2nd prize-winners to qualify for the semi-final to be held at the Blue Chip Native BSPS Heritage Show, Arena UK in October

For Dartmoor stallions, mares and geldings 4 years and over. Riders any age, except stallions where the rider must be 12 years and over as of the 1st of January in the current year.

Ponies, owners and riders need not be BSPS members to compete in this class BUT pony, rider and owner will need to register with the BSPS to compete in the Semi Final to be held at the Heritage Championship Show in October.

RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP (Classes 23 to 27)

SUPREME RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP (Champion and reserves from the Mini Championship and the above ridden championship)

QUALIFICATION FOR THE YOUNG RIDER CHAMPIONSHIP NPS Young Rider Championship.

The judge will award a qualification to the rider (in their opinion) most deserved under 25 years old in classes 20, 22,23,24,25 & 26

QUALIFICATION FOR THE NPS/ROSETTES DIRECT HOME PRODUCED RIDDEN NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP

In classes 21,22,24,25 & 26.The highest placed Home Produced pony will receive a qualification provided the rider is wearing a white armband.

UNAFFILIATED CLASSES

.Class 28 The NPS Senior Plus M&M & Plaited Ridden National Championship (O-VR)

Stallions,mares & geldings. Fifteen years old and over registered in the main body of their respective M&M Stud book. All horses & Ponies must be in a sound and healthy condition.

Class 29 Pairs In Hand or ridden (lead reins allowed).To be judged on suitability and performance.

Class 30 Young Handler. Aged 4 to 14. Mares and geldings only. Class may be split if entries warrant.

Class 31 The NPS Senior Plus M&M & Plaited In Hand National Championship (O-VIH)

Competition to be run using the same criteria as the Ridden Championship

Class 32 Senior Rider/Handler.Over 40 years.May be split if entries warrant.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR DESIGNATED BREED SHOWS

a) NPS Membership criteria

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to NPS members and non-members and at Breed shows ponies can qualify for the final even if their owners are not NPS members

The owner of the pony qualifying at a Breed show must become an NPS 'Qualifying for Life' member for the pony to enter the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show

At Breed shows ponies can win Silver Medal Rosettes even if their owners are not members of the NPS but they must become NPS 'Qualifying for Life' members to enter the final.

b) Judges

At Breed Shows, M&M classes and M&M Silver Medal Rosette Championships can be judged by an NPS Panel Judge or a judge from the Breed Panel concerned.

c) Classes

At Breed Shows competitions that are normally split into five classes will only have classes appropriate to that breed i.e. four classes at Welsh shows and one class at other Breed Shows

RULES AND CONDITIONS

1. The Judge's decision is final. The judges will be instructed to withhold any ordinary or special prize where there is evident lack of merit.
2. The Show reserves the right to take the opinion of a Veterinary Surgeon on any pony exhibited
3. The officials do not hold themselves responsible for any accident which may occur on the showground to spectators, competitors or animals .Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
4. Any person wishing to lodge a complaint having reference to any persons or exhibit, shall do so in writing within 30 minutes of the completion of the class or championship, and at the same time shall deposit the sum of £20.00.If an investigation by the committee proves that the objection is not sustained, the said committee reserves the right that the deposit shall be forfeited and paid into the funds of the show.
5. All foals must be a minimum of three weeks old on the day of the show.
6. The use of spurs in any ridden class is forbidden .No whips or canes to exceed 30" (76.2cms) in length.
7. The committee reserves the right to cancel or amalgamate any class
8. All stallions and colts three years and over must hold a current Ministry Of Agriculture, NPS or Dartmoor Pony Society Licence. All handlers of colts and stallions must have attained their 14th birthday and riders of stallions must have attained their 12th birthday by the 1st of January in the current year.
9. The Male, Female and Young stock Champions are required for the Supreme In Hand Championship.
10. Correctly secured skull caps/riding hats must be worn at ALL time when mounted.
11. **DPS rosettes presented to members only (Membership card to be shown in ring)**
12. NPS rules for affiliated classes (with the exception of class 27)
13. **The committee reserves the right to refuse entry.**
- 14 **All stallions must wear a clearly visible stallion bridle marker .These are available to purchase from the NPS office.**

NPS M&M Qualifying Rounds These classes are judged under the rules of the NPS .Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective M&M Stud Book .Part Breds are not eligible
The three highest placed ponies owned by an NPS member in each class will qualify for the final .Qualification can go no lower than 3rd place.

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships These classes are judged under the rules of the NPS. If the champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver medal Rosette but the qualification card goes to the reserve champion, .The Silver Medal Rosette and qualification can be awarded no lower than first reserve (3rd).Foals are not eligible for the Silver Medal Championships.

Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show (1-3 August) but must become NPS Qualifying for Life members to enter the final.

NPS M&M In Hand Silver Medal Rosette Championship

Sponsored by the Kilmannan Stud (SM-MMIH)

A Silver medal Rosette is offered by the NPS for the best registered pony in the M&M In Hand section. The sponsors' rosette is awarded to the pony receiving the qualification.

TSR Showing finals – This show is a qualifier for the 2017 TSR Regional Finals. Qualify and enter ANY of the Regional Finals Central, East Anglia, North West, North east, South East, South, Wales & South West or Scottish. You do not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals!

TSR Rider Finals – 1st and 2nd riders qualify and will receive a qualification card in the ring

TSR In Hand Finals – The two highest placed Handlers with a TSR In Hand Card will qualify in any In Hand class. Handlers MUST have their cards signed in the ring by the judge/steward, cards are available FREE from the TSR website. Full details at

From the north – (M1) Leave at junction 19,A14 Kettering.Leave A14 at junction 2 (A508 – Northampton)Leave A508 (turn left) through Pitsford village and follow detailed map.
From the south – (M1) Leave at junction 15 (Kettering).Leave A43 at Holcot Roundabout (turn left) and follow detailed map.From the east (A14) Leave at junction 8 (A43 Northampton)Leave A43 at Holcot roundabout (turn right) and follow detailed map
