The series is open to all fully registered Dartmoor ponies competing in ridden showing classes affiliated to the DPS, NPS or BSPS Heritage.

Ponies must be in the correct ownership for points to count. Registration into the series is required before points can be collected. This is done by printing the form from our website, filling in the details and sending to the office. You will then receive a points form to be returned **no later than 31<sup>st</sup> Dec 2022**.

All owners must be fully paid up members of the DPS before any points can count. Riders need not be members, it is the owner and pony combination that collects points.

Points from a maximum of **3 ridden classes** per day can be counted.

Classes must be affiliated to one of the following: DPS, NPS, or BSPS Heritage. Double points are awarded at DPS Breed Shows, DPS Star Shows and placings at the finals of the RIHS and HOYS. An extra 25 points are awarded for each RHIS and HOYS class where a pony qualifies for the final.

Points are awarded as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> place 10 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> place 8 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> place 6 points, 4<sup>th</sup> place 4 points.

The 6 ponies with the highest number of points will receive prizes. The owner or a representative of the owner must attend the prize giving, failure to do so will result in forfeit of the prize.

In the event of a pony being sold mid season the original pony owner points cannot be added to but can still be entered into the competition, the new pony/owner points can start from the day ownership is transferred.

Any complaints regarding the competition or an entrant should be sent in writing to the office by "signed" or "special" delivery, two separate letters must be received within 2 weeks of the closing date from unrelated members of different families to give rise to the complaint.
