<u>Class 21</u> The NPS/The King's Head M&M Novice Leading Rein National Championship (MM-NLR)

Open to registered Dartmoor mares and geldings 4 years old and over not exceeding 122cms.Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but must not have attained their 9th birthday before the 1st of January in the current year. Ponies never to have won a first prize of £10 or more in Leading Rein classes or qualified for the NPS/Showing classic M&M Leading Rein final before 1st January in the current year .To be shown in a snaffle bit with lead rein attached to nose band only.

<u>Class 22</u> The NPS/Bryndefaid Stud M&M Novice First Ridden National Championship (MM-NFR)

Open to registered Dartmoor mares and geldings 4 years old and over not exceeding 128cms.Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but must not have reached their 12th birthday before the 1st of January in the current year .Ponies never to have won a first prize of £10 or more in First Ridden classes or qualified for the NPS/Showing Classic M&M First Ridden final before the 1st of January in the current year.

<u>Class 23</u> The NPS/Showing Classics M&M Open Leading Rein National Championship and Cavernoma Alliance UK/Equifest M&M Lead Rein. (MM-LR) Open to registered Dartmoor mares and geldings 4 years and over not exceeding 122cms,Riders to have attained their 3rd birthday but must not have attained their 9th birthday in the current year.To be shown in a snaffle bit with lead reins attached to the noseband only.

Home Produced to wear white armbands.

<u>Class 24</u> The NPS/Showing Classics M&M Open First Ridden National Championship and The Jungle Hut/Equifest M&M First Ridden (MM-FR) Open to registered Dartmoor mares and geldings 4 years and over not exceeding 128cms.Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but must not have attained their 12th birthday before the 1st of January in the current year. Home Produced to wear white armbands.

MINI CHAMPIONSHIP. 1st and 2nd prize winners for classes 21 to 24

<u>Class 25</u> The NPS/Picton M&M Novice Ridden Championship (MM-NR) Open to pure bred registered Dartmoor stallions, mares and geldings 4 years and over.

A pony is not eligible to compete if, before the 1st of January in the current year it has done any of the following:

i) won an open NPS affiliated mixed M&M ridden class

ii) won a Ridden class in an Olympia, HOYS or RIHS Open M&M ridden class iii) qualified for the M&M Novice or Intermediate ridden final at the NPS Summer Show (NB Ponies can compete as novices in this competition for two consecutive years provided they do not submit an entry to the final in the first year)

v) if a pony qualifies for HOYS or RIHS in its second year it is immediately denoviced and cannot compete in Picton final.

Ponies must be shown in a snaffle bit

<u>Class 26</u> The NPS M&M Junior Ridden National Championship (MM-JR) and Equifest Junior Ridden M&M

Open to registered Dartmoor mare and geldings 4 years old and over. Riders must not have attained their 14th birthday before the 1st of January in the current year.

Home Produced to wear white armbands

<u>Class 27</u> The NPS/Dargavel M&M Young Pony National Championships (MM-4/5/6R)

Open to pure bred registered Dartmoor stallions, mares and geldings 4, 5 and 6 years old. Rider any age, except stallions where the rider must be 12 years and over in the current year. Ages will be split at NPS Final.

Qualification will be awarded to the highest placed 4, 5 & 6 year old. Home Produced to wear white armbands

<u>Class 28</u> The NPS/Ringside Stud M&M Open Ridden National Championship and Equifest Open Ridden M&M (MM-OR)

Open to pure bred registered Dartmoor stallions, mares and geldings 5 years and over. Riders any age except stallions where riders must be 12 years and over in the current year.

Home Produced to wear white armbands

<u>Class 29</u> The B.S.P.S. Heritage CHAMPIONSHIP RIDDEN CLASS. 1st and 2nd prizewinners to qualify for the semi-final to be held at the BSPS Heritage Show, Arena UK.

For Dartmoor stallions, mares and geldings 4 years and over. Riders any age, except stallions where the rider must be 12 years and over as of the 1st of January in the current year.

Ponies, owners and riders need not be BSPS members to compete in this class BUT pony, rider and owner will need to register with the BSPS to compete in the Semi Final to be held at the Heritage Championship Show. Please see the 2023 BSPS Rule and Show Handbook.

RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP (Classes 25 to 29)

SUPREME RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP (Champion and reserves from the Mini Championship and the above ridden championship)

The judge will award a qualification to the rider (in their opinion) most deserved under 25 years old in classes 20, 22,23,24,25 & 26 QUALIFICATION FOR THE NPS/CORSCARON HORSE ESSENTIALS HOME PRODUCED RIDDEN NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP

In classes 21,22,24,25 & 26. The highest placed Home Produced pony will receive a qualification provided the rider is wearing a white armband.

<u>Class 32</u> Young Handler. Aged 4 to 14. Mares and geldings only. Class may be split if entries warrant.

<u>Class 33</u> In Hand Veteran. Fifteen years old and over as above.

<u>Class 34</u> Senior Rider/Handler. Over 40 years. May be split if entries warrant.

<u>Class 35</u> Progeny. For 2 or more ponies, any age, with at least one shared parent. The parent may/may not be present in the ring **(this class will be held after the championship for classes 8-13 in Ring 1)**

<u>Class 36</u> Part-bred, any age. To be 25% registered Dartmoor pony **(to be held after Progeny class in Ring 1)**

SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR DESIGNATED BREED SHOWS

a) NPS Membership criteria

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to NPS members and non-members and at Breed shows ponies can qualify for the final even if their owners are not NPS members

The owner of the pony qualifying at a Breed show must become an NPS 'Qualifying or Life' member for the pony to enter the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show

At Breed shows ponies can win Silver Medal Rosettes even if their owners are not members of the NPS but they must become NPS 'Qualifying or Life' members to enter the final.

b) Judges

At Breed Shows, M&M classes and M&M Silver Medal Rosette Championships can be judged by an NPS Panel Judge or a judge from the Breed Panel concerned.

EQUINE INFLUENZA VACCINATIONS ARE A COMPULSORY REQUIREMENT FOR ALL HORSES/PONIES COMPETING IN NPS AFFLIATED CLASSES. THE REQUIREMENT FOR THE FIRST 3 VACCINATIONS IS AS FOLLOWS: THE FIRST 2 VACCINATIONS 21 TO 92 DAYS APART, A THIRD BOOSTER BETWEEN 150 – 215 DAYS AND AN ANNUAL BOOSTER WITHIN 365 DAYS THEREAFTER. NO ANIMAL SHOULD ENTER COMPETITIONS WITHIN 7 DAYS OF AN E1 VACCINATION. FOALS SHOULD COMMENCE VACCINATIONS AT 6 MONTHS OLD. THIS RULE MAY BE SUBJECT TO CHANGE FOLLOWING GUIDANCE FROM THE FEI/BEF AND ANY CHANGES WILL BE NOTIFIED VIA THE NPS WEBSITE.

ALL PONIES COMPETING AT THIS SHOW MUST HAVE HAD AT LEAST THE FIRST 2 PRIMARY VACCINATIONS.

RULES AND CONDITIONS

- <u>1.</u> The Judge's decision is final. The judges will be instructed to withhold any ordinary or special prize where there is evident lack of merit.
- 2. The Show reserves the right to take the opinion of a Veterinary Surgeon on any pony exhibited
- 3. The officials do not hold themselves responsible for any accident which may occur on the showground to spectators, competitors or animals .Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
- <u>4.</u> Any person wishing to lodge a complaint having reference to any persons or exhibit, shall do so in writing within 30 minutes of the completion of the class or championship, and at the same time shall deposit the sum of £20.00.If an investigation by the committee proves that the objection is not sustained, the said committee reserves the right that the deposit shall be forfeited and paid into the funds of the show.
- 5. All foals must be a minimum of three weeks old on the day of the show.
- 6. The use of spurs in any ridden class is forbidden .No whips or canes to exceed 30" (76.2cms) in length.
- 7. The committee reserves the right to cancel or amalgamate any class
- 8. All stallions and colts three years and over must hold a current Ministry Of Agriculture, NPS or Dartmoor Pony Society Licence. All handlers of colts and stallions must have attained their 14th birthday and riders of stallions must have attained their 12th birthday by the 1st of January in the current year.
- 9. The Male, Female and Young stock Champions are required for the Supreme In Hand Championship.
- 10.
 Correctly secured skull caps/riding hats must be worn at ALL time when mounted.

 RIDERS IN BSPS CLASSES WILL BE REQUIRED TO COMPLY WITH RULE 43 IN THE 2023 BSPS HANDBOOK WITH

 REGARD TO HAT TAGGING AND SPECIFICATION
- 11. DPS rosettes presented to members only (Membership card to be shown in ring)
- 12. NPS rules for affiliated classes (with the exception of class 29)
- 13. The committee reserves the right to refuse entry.

14 All ridden stallions must wear a clearly visible stallion bridle marker .These are available to purchase from the NPS office. It is advised that in hand stallions display a bridle marker.

<u>NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships</u> These classes are judged under the rules of the NPS. If the champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver medal Rosette but the qualification card goes to the reserve champion, .The Silver Medal Rosette and qualification can be awarded no lower than first reserve (3rd).Foals are not eligible for the Silver Medal Championships.

Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show (August) but must become NPS Qualifying or Life members to enter the final.

NPS M&M In Hand Silver Medal Rosette Championship

Sponsored by the Blackertor & Sharptor Stud (SM-MMIH)

A Silver medal Rosette is offered by the NPS for the best registered pony in the M&M In Hand section. The sponsors' rosette is awarded to the pony receiving the qualification.
