## **RIDDEN CLASSES RING TWO**

### **JUDGE – Ms S Prior**

Class 22 The NPS/The King's Head M&M Novice Leading Rein National Championship (MM-NLR)

Open to registered Dartmoor mares and geldings 4 years old and over not exceeding 122cms. Riders must have attained their 3<sup>rd</sup> birthday but must not have attained their 9<sup>th</sup> birthday before the 1<sup>st</sup> of January in the current year. Ponies never to have won a first prize of £10 or more in Leading Rein classes or qualified for the NPS/Showing Classics M&M Leading Rein final before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year. To be shown in a snaffle bit with lead rein attached to nose band only.

Class 23 The NPS/Bryndefaid Stud M&M Novice First Ridden National Championship (MM-NFR)

Open to registered Dartmoor mares and geldings 4 years old and over not exceeding 128cms. Riders must have attained their 3<sup>rd</sup> birthday but must not have reached their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday before the 1<sup>st</sup> of January in the current year. Ponies never to have won a first prize of £10 or more in First Ridden classes or qualified for the NPS/Partridge & Parr M&M First Ridden final before the 1<sup>st</sup> of January in the current year.

Class 24 The NPS/Showing Classics M&M Open Leading Rein National Championship (MM-LR)

Open to registered Dartmoor mares and geldings 4 years and over not exceeding 122cms, Riders to have attained their 3<sup>rd</sup> birthday but must not have attained their 9<sup>th</sup> birthday in the current year. To be shown in a snaffle bit with lead reins attached to the noseband only.  
Home Produced to wear white armbands.

Class 25 The NPS/Partridge & Parr M&M Open First Ridden National Championship (MM-FR)

Open to registered Dartmoor mares and geldings 4 years and over not exceeding 128cms. Riders must have attained their 3<sup>rd</sup> birthday but must not have attained their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday before the 1<sup>st</sup> of January in the current year.  
Home Produced to wear white armbands.

**MINI CHAMPIONSHIP.** 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners for classes 22 to 25

Class 26 The NPS/Picton M&M Novice Ridden Championship (MM-NR)  
Open to pure bred registered Dartmoor stallions, mares and geldings 4 years and over.

A pony is not eligible to compete if, before the 1<sup>st</sup> of January in the current year it has done any of the following:

- i) won an open NPS affiliated mixed M&M ridden class
- ii) won a Ridden class in an LIHS, HOYS or RIHS Open M&M ridden class
- iii) qualified for the M&M Novice or Intermediate ridden final at the NPS Summer Show (NB Ponies can compete as novices in this competition for two consecutive years provided they do not submit an entry to the final in the first year)
- v) if a pony qualifies for HOYS or RIHS in its second year it is immediately de-noviced and cannot compete in Picton final.

Ponies must be shown in a snaffle bit

Class 27 The NPS M&M Junior Ridden National Championship (MM-JR) Junior Ridden M&M

Open to registered Dartmoor mare and geldings 4 years old and over. Riders must not have attained their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday before the 1<sup>st</sup> of January in the current year.

Home Produced to wear white armbands

Class 28 The NPS/Dargavel M&M Young Pony National Championships (MM-4/5/6R)

Open to pure bred registered Dartmoor stallions, mares and geldings 4, 5 and 6 years old. Rider any age, except stallions where the rider must be 12 years and over in the current year. Ages will be split at NPS Final.

Qualification will be awarded to the highest placed 4, 5 & 6 year old.

Home Produced to wear white armbands

Class 29 The NPS/Ringside Stud M&M Open Ridden National Championship  
Open Ridden M&M (MM-OR)

Open to pure bred registered Dartmoor stallions, mares and geldings 5 years and over. Riders any age except stallions where riders must be 12 years and over in the current year.

Home Produced to wear white armbands

Class 30 The B.S.P.S. NEW HORIZON PLASTICS Heritage CHAMPIONSHIP RIDDEN CLASS. 1<sup>st</sup> - 3rd prize-winners to qualify for the semi-final to be held at the BSPS Heritage Show, Arena UK.

For Dartmoor stallions, mares and geldings 4 years and over. Riders any age, except stallions where the rider must be 12 years and over as of the 1<sup>st</sup> of January in the current year.

Ponies, owners and riders need not be BSPS members to compete in this class BUT pony, rider and owner will need to register with the BSPS to compete in the Semi Final to be held at the Heritage Championship Show. Please see the 2026 BSPS Rule and Show Handbook.

**SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR DESIGNATED BREED SHOWS**

**a) NPS Membership criteria**

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to NPS members and non-members and at Breed shows ponies can qualify for the final even if their owners are not NPS members

The owner of the pony qualifying at a Breed show must become an NPS 'Qualifying or Life' member for the pony to enter the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show

At Breed shows ponies can win Silver Medal Rosettes even if their owners are not members of the NPS but they must become NPS 'Qualifying or Life' members to enter the final.

**b) Judges**

At Breed Shows, M&M classes and M&M Silver Medal Rosette Championships can be judged by an NPS Panel Judge or a judge from the Breed Panel concerned.

**EQUINE INFLUENZA VACCINATIONS ARE A COMPULSORY REQUIREMENT FOR ALL HORSES/PONIES COMPETING IN NPS AFFILIATED CLASSES. THE REQUIREMENT FOR THE FIRST 3 VACCINATIONS IS AS FOLLOWS: THE FIRST 2 VACCINATIONS 21 TO 60 DAYS APART, A THIRD BOOSTER BETWEEN 100 – 180 DAYS AND AN ANNUAL BOOSTER WITHIN 365 DAYS THEREAFTER. NO ANIMAL SHOULD ENTER COMPETITIONS WITHIN 7 DAYS OF AN E1 VACCINATION. FOALS SHOULD COMMENCE VACCINATIONS AT 6 MONTHS OLD. THIS RULE MAY BE SUBJECT TO CHANGE FOLLOWING GUIDANCE FROM THE FEI/BEF AND ANY CHANGES WILL BE NOTIFIED VIA THE NPS WEBSITE.**

**ALL PONIES COMPETING AT THIS SHOW MUST HAVE HAD AT LEAST THE FIRST 2 PRIMARY VACCINATIONS.**

## RULES AND CONDITIONS

1. The Judge's decision is final. The judges will be instructed to withhold any ordinary or special prize where there is evident lack of merit.
2. The Show reserves the right to take the opinion of a Veterinary Surgeon on any pony exhibited
3. The officials do not hold themselves responsible for any accident which may occur on the showground to spectators, competitors or animals .Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
4. Any person wishing to lodge a complaint having reference to any persons or exhibit, shall do so in writing within 30 minutes of the completion of the class or championship, and at the same time shall deposit the sum of £20.00.If an investigation by the committee proves that the objection is not sustained, the said committee reserves the right that the deposit shall be forfeited and paid into the funds of the show.
5. All foals must be a minimum of three weeks old on the day of the show.
6. The use of spurs in any ridden class is forbidden .No whips or canes to exceed 30" (76.2cms) in length.
7. The committee reserves the right to cancel or amalgamate any class
8. All stallions and colts three years and over must hold a current Ministry Of Agriculture, NPS or Dartmoor Pony Society Licence. All handlers of colts and stallions must have attained their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday and riders of stallions must have attained their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday by the 1<sup>st</sup> of January in the current year.
9. The Male, Female and Young stock Champions are required for the Supreme In Hand Championship.
10. Correctly secured skull caps/riding hats must be worn at ALL time when mounted.

### **RIDERS IN BSPS CLASSES WILL BE REQUIRED TO COMPLY WITH RULE 43 IN THE 2026 BSPS HANDBOOK WITH REGARD TO HAT TAGGING AND SPECIFICATION**

11. **DPS rosettes presented to members only (Membership card to be shown in ring)**
12. NPS rules for affiliated classes (with the exception of class 30)
13. **The committee reserves the right to refuse entry.**

### **14 All ridden stallions must wear a clearly visible stallion bridle marker .These are available to purchase from the NPS office. It is advised that in hand stallions display a bridle marker.**

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships These classes are judged under the rules of the NPS. If the champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver medal Rosette but the qualification card goes to the reserve champion, .The Silver Medal Rosette and qualification can be awarded no lower than first reserve (3<sup>rd</sup>).Foals are not eligible for the Silver Medal Championships.

Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show ( August) but must become NPS Qualifying or Life members to enter the final.

#### NPS M&M In Hand Silver Medal Rosette Championship Sponsored by the Blackertor & Sharptor Stud (SM-MMIH)

A Silver medal Rosette is offered by the NPS for the best registered pony in the M&M In Hand section. The sponsors' rosette is awarded to the pony receiving the qualification.

**IT IS A CONDITION OF ENTRY THAT ALL EXHIBITORS ENTERING THIS SHOW MUST BE COVERED FOR THIRD PARTY LIABILITY INSURANCE. THIS CAN EITHER BE IN THE FORM OF A PERSONAL POLICY OR THROUGH MEMBERSHIP OF AN ORGANISATION THAT PROVIDES COVER, SUCH AS THE BHS**
